Ned Pratt is a photographer inspired by the stark and majestic landscapes of his home island of Newfoundland. His photographs often juxtapose a single man made structure against a backdrop of sea, sky, and land. This composition breaks with traditional rules of photography.. The effect results in photographs that are more abstracted and minimal.





Terms to think about:

Horizon Line

The point where water or land meet sky, forming a natural line that anchors and divides a photograph.

Composition

The way in which different elements of an artwork are arranged or put together.

Balance

Balance is a composition technique that arranges elements within the frame to achieve equal visual weight across the image.
